

Initial thinking: new elements of the ENTSO-E consultation policy

Product development approach fit for each deliverable

Differentiated requirements depending on complexity, scope, legal deadlines, urgency of a deliverable

Duration of consultations adaptable to type of deliverable

Visibility, clarity, and transparency

An 'inception document' accompanying each consultation

ENTSO-E website, consultation hub, newsletters, ENTSO-E Annual Work Program, NC app

Various channels for stakeholder contributions at all stages of product development

A 'simplified consultation response procedure'
Standardized consultation format with structured survey questions
Co-creation with stakeholders – peer review process

Early engagement opportunities for stakeholder input

Stakeholder workshops/webinars at the different stages of product development
Best use of ENTSO-E advisory stakeholder groups (iAC, ESCs, etc.)

Quality of consultations & consistency across deliverables
