## Report on assessing the level of harmonization of the rules for suspension and restoration of market activities

# Start of the process

- Tracking submission of deliverables to NRAs
- Once there is enough national proposals approved by NRAs start the work
- Expected: September 2019 work has started (only 8 rules are approved so far)

### Analysis

- The report aim at identifying the gaps and inconsistencies, and identify where there may be an opportunity for harmonisation.
- The report does not look for harmonization as a purpose itself, but provide an overview on the current situation including identification of areas where harmonization would be beneficial

# Main content of the rules

- Suspension of activities of Balancing/Ancillary Services Market
- Suspension of provision of cross-zonal capacity
- Suspension of Single Day Ahead Coupling/Single Intraday Coupling (SDAC/SIDC)

#### Webinar

- ENTSO-E will prepare a webinar, with main topics:
  - General topic of suspension of market activities
  - Survey to be filled by TSOs
- Webinar will be held in the end February / beginning of March (exact date to be communicated in advance)

#### **Process**

Selected 5 TSOs whose national rules should be translated to EN. (end-Oct)

Analyse the translated rules to identify key content

Draft template of key questions, for each TSO to answer in English.

Consult with stakeholde rs + adding received recommen dations (webinar + MESC 2020)

Launch survey (fill in template)

**Drafting** the report (start Q2-2020)

Involve stakeholde rs on status updates (MESC, webinars..)

Final submission of the report: (Deadline Dec. 2020)
