## ENTSO-e analysis of the list of services in Art 34 and Annex I of Regulation recast (COM 861)

ENTSO-E supports, in general, the approach of enhancing regional cooperation with additional services, when: i) services are identified in accordance with the Regional Security Coordination model under the SOGL and ii) their efficiency is properly assessed at the relevant geographical level.

(l) Training and certification	TSOs training for operators, in a jointly basis for relevant topics already exist. Not role for service provider in certifying control room operators responsible for real time. RSCs involvement in training of employees in charge of regional activities.
(m) Identification of regional crisis scenarios if this task is delegated by ENTSO & (o) Tasks related to the identification of regional crisis scenarios if and to the extent they are delegated to ROCs	Both (m) and (n) services refer to the same service. Identification of regional crisis scenarios is described in RPP regulation (art 6.1). Recommend to use text: "Tasks related to the identification of regional crisis scenarios if these tasks are delegated by ENTSOE".
(n) Preparation and carrying out of yearly crisis simulations in cooperation with competent authorities	Simulation of regional crisis scenarios is described in RPP regulation (art 12.3). Competent national authorities shall coordinate crissis situations at regional level. TSOs, as technical responsible body, will be supported by RSCs. Recomend to use text: "Supporting TSOs and competent authorities in the preparition and carrying out of yearly crisis simulations"
(p) Tasks related to the seasonal adequacy outlooks if and to the extent they are delegated to the regional operational centres pursuant	Cooperative processes, involving RSCs as convinient, already exist within ENTSO-E
(q) Calculate the maximum entry capacity available for the participation of foreign capacity in capacity mechanisms	Serious concern – policitical and deep regulatory implications - not sense to approach as purely functional topic
