1. Welcome, practicalities

The chairs open the meeting by welcoming TSOs and NEMOs.

1.1) Confirm quorum

The MCSC attendance is meeting the quorum requirements.

1.2) Adoption of the agenda

The meeting agenda is approved.

1.3) Matching of pre-aligned NEMO Vote and TSO Vote

2. JOINT Part - General

2.1) Approval of minutes (internal & external)

The minutes of the MCSC meeting on 27/09/2023 are approved.

The minutes extract of the 27/09/2023 meeting is approved for publication under the dedicated SDAC & SIDC section at the ENTSO-E and NC websites.

2.2) Review of action points

2.3) PMO presence in physical meetings

MCSC has agreed on the set-up of PMO presence during MCSC physical meetings so as to ensure streamlined proceedings.

2.4) MCSC confirmation of Conveners

The convenorship term of several MCSC conveners is soon coming to an end. Following respective (re)appointments, MCSC has approved convenorship (extensions) of the appointed candidates.

3. JOINT Part - Decisions requested & for information topics

3.1) BMTF

Building on the proposal presented to parties during the 27/09 MCSC meeting, BMTF has delivered the final 2024 budget as well as the 3-year forecast (2025-2027) for the SDAC and SIDC Joint NEMOs and TSOs costs. Among other specifics included in the budget, MCSC discussion has particularly focused on the extent to which contingency related to the cooptimisation should be forseen within the 2024 SDAC budget.

3.2) Gov TF

Following on an internal alignment, MCSC has decided to temporarily freeze the Gov TF until further notice. MCSC satisfaction survey, previously carried out by the Gov TF, will therefore not be conducted by this entity in 2024. Consequently, the 2024 budget allocated to Gov TF has been adjusted, providing coverage only for ad-hoc requests (if any) and CACM 2.0 TCM drafting (upon reactivation).

3.3) Legal TF

The focus of discussion regarding LTF inputs was put on draft materials for the upcoming IT tender, specifically the Mandate Agreement and Co-ownership principles. MCSC approved both drafts as well as the related next steps. Aside







from the tender preparation. LTF infomed MCSC also about the progress in drafting consolidated main text of the IDOA amendment for IDA which is envisioned to be available for MCSC approval during November MCSC meeting.

3.4) MCCG

Feedback from market participants are an important input for MCSC market design decision-making. With this in consideration, MCCG Conveners shared with MCSC the main insights, defined actions, and other outcomes of the MCCG #4 meeting which took place on 20/10/2023. Building on this input, MCSC has discussed the next steps for internal and external stakeholder engagement related especially to the work on market design & operational timings for the 15 min MTU implementation in SDAC as well as IDAs implementation in SIDC.

4. SDAC - Decisions requested & for information topics

4.1) SDAC MSD

Based on the simulations conducted to determine the time needed for safe calculations of the daily market coupling results as well as on previous MCSC and external discussions, SDAC MSD proposed to set the calculation time for 30 minutes. Approved by MCSC, such calculation time extension shall support 15 min MTU implementation, providing satisfactory results in terms of the number of solutions found as well as welfare gain while minimizing potential negative impacts.

Moreover, to ensure acceptable algorithm performance, NEMOs will monitor the market participants' bidding behavior, providing MCSC with bidding splits data for further analysis. As for the product mix, in depth analysis of the possible products and impacts on the algorithm performance will be conducted by SDAC MSD.

5. SIDC – Decisions requested & for Information topics

5.1) SIDC QARM

The main point of discussion led by SIDC QARM was the recent status of IDA testing and resulting impacts on IDA Go-Live planning. Conditional on the results of tests planned for the end of October, 2023, QARM and IDA TG are to optimize the IDA testing and Go-Live preparation timeline to mitigate potential delays. Final MCSC approval of IDA Go-Live plan is envisioned to take place during November MCSC meeting.
